in the vineyard

The grapes come from the Paarl region, a sub-region within the greater Coastal region.

about the harvest

Hand picked Shiraz grapes picked at optimum ripeness to ensure a full bodied red wine.

in the cellar

Aged in first fill barrels for 8-12 months.
